

Recertification for Canada Soccer B License Part 1 Coaches

Canada Soccer, in conjunction with Provincial Associations, are improving and updating the information being offered at the A and B License courses. It is imperative the NLSA coaches keep up-to-date on the changes that are being made within the Canada Soccer license pathway. Continuing coaching education will maintain high standards, ensure knowledge of the most current and relevant information, and, most important, foster player development.

If you passed your B License Part 1 prior to 2015, your license has expired and you need to **recertify**.

After 2021, recertification will not be an option and coaches will be expected to attend the new Canada Soccer B license Part 1 course (formerly known as Provincial B). The new B License Part 1 course is being designed and introduced in 2021.

To recertify in 2020, coaches can complete a video-based evaluation or request a live assessment. Recertification assessment will include a Pre-Brief, Session Review, De-Brief and Action Plan.
